Activities in Central London

- Get some green-fingered inspiration at the [Garden Museum](#), where [Derek Jarman: My Garden's Boundaries are the Horizon](#) exhibition is currently on.

Activities in South London

- Get the kids asking "Is that a real dinosaur?!" around every corner at [Crystal Palace Park](#).
- Wander through the vast gardens of the [Horniman Museum](#). Try to spot the velociraptor in the Prehistoric Gardens, find wild landscapes in the Grasslands Garden and marvel at the flowers in the Sunken and Display Gardens.
- The 19-acre (8-hectare) gardens of medieval [Eltham Palace](#) are a great place to explore with a moat, pools and water features to discover.
- Take in the sunshine at [Battersea Park](#), spotting fountains and the Peace Pagoda on the way. You can also greet the animals at [Battersea Park Children's Zoo](#).
- Don't miss a chance to ride the miniature railway at [Brockwell Park](#) on Sundays, even if you're not so little!
