Maths We will be working with numbers to 100. We will be counting forwards and backwards. We will partition a number into tens and ones. We will compare 2 numbers to say which is more or less. We will be finding 1 / 10 more and 1 / 10 less than a number. We will be learning to add and subtract using objects and a number line for support. We will be finding pairs of numbers that make 10 / 20 /100. We will be counting in 2, 5s and 10s. We will be singing number songs.	Encourage practical maths – eg. finding shapes around the house and outside, counting, telling the time, helping to pay at the shops, helping with cooking.
