Florence Nightingale Museum Trip – Green Class

Green class had a wonderful trip up to the Florence Nightingale Museum at St. Thomas hospital on Wednesday 19 June.

We travelled there by bus and when we got to the museum, we were greeted by Florence Nightingale herself! She brought us into the museum and the children sat on the floor as she gave a wonderful talk about her growing up, her family, why she wanted to become a nurse, the Crimean war and her life after she returned to England. Some of the children were invited up to be a part of the talk by taking on various roles. The children did themselves and the school proud by being able to answer all of the questions that were put to them, including the name of her pet owl (Athena, by the way, that was courtesy of Aryanna). The children then got to take part in a treasure hunt around the museum and they had to find 15 items that were linked to Florence herself, such as the Nightingale badge, her early nurse's uniform, and the medicine box she used. There were period costumes for the children to try on as well during their visit around the museum as well as toys of the time also.

It was very different from what they are used to today! All in all, Green Class had a wonderful day and their behaviour was absolutely impeccable throughout. They got a lot out of it so I hope you will talk to your children about their time there. A big thank you to Rosa Anderson (Talia's mum) and Caddy Pettard (Lennon's mum) for generously giving up their time and coming the trip with us. The children and I greatly appreciate it.
