### Another outstanding set of results for John Ruskin children in 2025

We are really pleased with our results. Years 6 have performed really well in their end of year tests, with John Ruskin pupils achieving above the national average for expected levels in all areas. National data for greater depth has not yet been published.

Phonics tests were also taken by children in year 1, with 80% of children in the main school meeting the required standard.

Year 4 Multiplication Tables check – the children did really well with 75% of children scoring 20+.

Children in pink and blue were assessed against the new profile standards and 50% of the children achieved the Good Level of development.





#### **Curriculum in Action**



This term, we had our second STEM fair. Teachers put on some fun, interactive and educational activities linked to STEM subjects—science, technology, engineering and maths. It was an event to engage pupils with subjects that play a big part of modern life, and will certainly be involved in the industries many of them go on to work in one day.

A big thank you to all staff involved with preparing and running it and to the parents and pupils who came along. It was wonderful to see so many people getting involved in the full range of activities.











Activities included the magic milk experiment, coding with Bee Bots, spaghetti and marshmallow towers, jumping lizards with static electricity, sailing boats, rockets, paper aeroplanes more! It was lots of fun for the pupils AND the parents.











The spaghetti and marshmallow towers were very impressive. Well done to Lyna and Anas who created the tallest, free-standing tower—impressive work!


